



Membership

The CMRS welcomes all persons who enjoy the hobby of model railroading. We encourage those who are interested and willing to contribute their time and skills for the construction, maintenance or operation of our model railroad and our building, to submit an application for membership. Benefits of membership include: new friends with a common interest, the opportunity to improve modeling skills and learn new techniques, and of course the pleasure of operating trains on a world-class layout.

Regular Membership; Probationary Senior, Senior and Youth

Senior membership provides voting rights, the opportunity to serve as an Officer, Board member, Committee Chair or Superintendent, and all other privileges and responsibilities accorded a Senior Member, including a key and use of the club facilities for their intended purposes. Senior members must be at least 18 years of age. To maintain membership privileges your dues and assessments must be kept current.

Youth Member: This is available for youth 14 thru 17 years of age. A Youth applicant must have the written and signed consent and permission of and from his or her legal guardian. Furthermore, the legal guardian must agree, if necessary, to be responsible for said Youth Member and, if necessary, supervise said Youth Member at any and all the events or activities. Dues are five dollars (5) per month. The completion of a Youth Application is required for Youth applicants.

Application process Senior Membership: The process begins with the submission of a completed Application and the payment of three months dues in advance. This will enroll you as a Probationary Senior Member. This period allows a new member to become acquainted with the club and its members. It also allows the member to demonstrate their skills and willingness to participate in the projects and activities of the club. Probationary members are welcome at the club any time there are Senior Members present.

Upon completion of a minimum six-month probationary period, a request for advancement to Regular Senior Membership may be submitted. This requires the signatures of two Senior Members who agree to sponsor you. You must have read the CMRS Bylaws and agree to abide by and respect the Bylaws and all Policies and Procedures of the CMRS. The Board will present your name to the membership, as stated in the Bylaws, for a vote of acceptance. If accepted as a Senior member you will be responsible for monthly dues of \$20 and the payment of a one time building fee of \$_____.
